- to principle

- in home
- on Nile
- in Pharaoh's house

Moses:

- weaned by Mom
- raised by princess

God is still sovereign thru:

- oppression
- intensifying opposition
- threats & violence
- restricted resources
- unmet quotas
- frustrating failures
- withdrawn approval
- hardening of hearts by antagonist
- chased by enemy
- afraid
- mentally subjugated & oppressed
- infected by imagery of inferiority

Observance

- Passover

Only step of faith Israelites had to take of 10
plagues

- Death of a Lamb
- Application of the Blood

Original observance

- situated deliverance

Subsequent observances

- celebrated deliverance

- to Promised Land
